Excitement is building as we prepare for our trip to Uganda. Over 2 ½ years ago, Ray Wilson Jr. answered a call for aid from Pastor Kavuma Fred in Luweero, Uganda. Ray's trip was fruitful as he saw the great need there and knew that Black Buffalo Global Missions could make a difference and partner with this great ministry. Although Ray suffered a life changing stroke just a few weeks later, his vision for Uganda is still being carried on today by BBGM.



Over the past few years, we have been feeding 200 plus children daily, providing an education, daily bible instruction, prayer and worship. We have also helped with many projects: housing for our teachers, clean water, rebuilding the primary school, new bathrooms, holiday outreaches, soccer ministries and more!

This October, there are four of us travelling to Uganda to see the mission first hand. Our group will include, Gordon Warriner and his grandson, Luke Warriner, Ray's son-in-law Barry Bliss, and Barry's daughter, Laney Bliss.

Our goal is to see the mission in Uganda, but we are also wanting to be a blessing. We have been collecting money to buy the school children shoes, mosquito nets, mattresses to sleep on, among other things that are needed. While we are there, we will be involved in ministry to the children, youth, ladies' conference and Sunday services.
